Manufacturers Engage

The Chamber has become the hub for Macomb County's manufacturing community, including closely related industries like engineering and industrial design. We call this hub Manufacturers Engage, an initiative that includes programming and platform for manufacturers to share their challenges, best practices, ideas and resources. The group meets regularly to discuss "what's keeping them up at night" and to dialogue on potential solutions. An "un-conference" is held annually in the spring to share information about the conversations that have been had throughout the past year and how far we've been able to move the needle on some of the key issues areas identified by the manufacturing community. Smaller groups get together a few times a year to help shift that needle, particularly on the current issues of concern, including addressing the talent shortage by changing the culture and branding surrounding manufacturing and by getting manufacturers more consistently engaged with our public K-12 school systems. This group also works to plan educational events and develop products and services that are relevant to today's manufacturers.
